



## Billy Barham

June 2, 1925 - March 7, 2007

Billy Barham passed away Wednesday, March 7, 2007 at the age of 81 years. He was born June 2, 1925, to Guy Spence Barham, Sr. and Ruby Rumfield Barham in San Antonio, Texas. He was preceded in death by his 4 year old son, William Spence Barham, sister Marion Katheryn, brother Guy Spence, Jr., sister Ruby Wigley, and brother Cecil Roy Barham. He is survived by his wife of 56 years, Willie Bee Barham, daughter, Peggy Corkran, and husband Dennis, grandson, Daniel Corkran, brother, Bobby Barham and wife Joyce, brother-in-law Thomas Murray and wife Betty, sister-in-law Helen Barham, and beloved nieces and nephews. He joined the US Army on June 2, 1943, and served at Burtonwood Airbase in England. His reserve unit was recalled during the Korean War. He and Willie Bee traveled to England several times in the 1990s for reunions of the Burtonwood airmen of WWII and continue to maintain and cherish the friendships formed on these trips. After discharge from the military, Billy was employed by the City Public Service of San Antonio for 38 years.
