Billy Palmer loving father, husband, grandfather, and great-grandfather left the world to rejoice with the lord on January 14, 2006 at the age of 78. After graduating he enlisted in the Navy in 1945 for the purpose of fighting in WWII. Though he was too late to fight in the war he continued his service as a Seaman First Class. A year later on June 22, 1946, after returning home, he married his high school sweet heart Leah Joyce Stoddard and was happily married for 58 years. On February 16, 1954 Joyce gave birth to William Michael their first child and on October 16, 1957 gave birth to Mark Wayne. He leaves behind his brother Lewis, his sister Faye SoRelle, his sons Mike and Mark, his daughter-in-laws Donna, Linda, Jessica and soon to be daughter-in-law Siobhan McQueeney, grandchildren Michael, Jennifer, Mark Jr., and Matthew, and great grandson William Michael III. He had a successful career as a project manager for commercial buildings with the Marriot Corporation and other large corporations. He retired at the age 65 in Cotopaxi, Colorado where he built the house of his dreams on the land he had owned for 30 years. In the late 90's he returned to San Antonio to help run the family business, Southwest Event Services. Though he was tough and a man of few words, he loved everyone that was close to him, and he will be
