



## BJ (Bryan) Toscano

November 21, 1976 - June 30, 2018

Bryan James Toscano, best known as BJ, a lifelong resident of San Antonio, TX, passed away unexpectedly at the age of 41.

BJ was born on November 21, 1976 to Jimmy and Sandy Toscano (ne Hirtle). He graduated from Robert E. Lee High School, and had devoted himself to a career in quality customer service as a Data Integrity Representative with SWBC.

In addition to distinction in his work, BJ strived for excellence in being a wonderful “dad” to Ranger; an honorable son to his parents; an admirable older brother to his siblings; a respectable role model to his niece and nephews; and last but not least, a trustworthy and never judgmental friend to all who were lucky enough to know him.

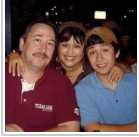

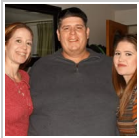
