Her love of music continued throughout adult hood and her talent led her to many radio programs to include KONO with her bother Jerry O'Dell, WOAI Radio Rodeo, Channel 5 daily program, and in 1960 she was a special guest on KWKH's Louisiana Hayride with James O'Gwynn.
