



## Carl A. "CA" McGhee

August 9, 1936 - September 8, 2020

Carl Albert "CA" McGhee Jr. was called home by our Lord with his family by his side on September 8, 2020 at St. Luke's Baptist Hospital in San Antonio at the age of 84. CA was born in Elmendorf Texas on August 9, 1936 to Carl and Margaret (Mair) McGhee.

CA graduated from East Central High School in 1954, where he was voted "Senior Class Favorite." He played football, baseball, was a member of the FFA and the newspaper staff. After graduating High School, he began work at Joske's in downtown San Antonio, working in the warehouse and making deliveries. In 1959, he was drafted and served in the Air Force and the Air National Guard until 1963.

CA worked at CPS Energy-Electric Department for 35 years. He enjoyed his time at CPS and met many lifelong friends. He was known by his co-workers as "Maggie." After retiring from CPS, he worked for F&W Electric as a contract inspector for CPS. He later worked at Hertz Rentals for several years driving rental cars throughout Texas. He enjoyed his road trips with the other retirees; including some of his family and friends, Jack Miller, Butch Kosub and many others.

CA was a member of the Texas Masonic Lodge No.8 since 1970. He enjoyed listening to country music, watching old country music shows on TV, dancing, fishing, hunting, making amazing barbecue for his family, working crossword puzzles & the Cryptoquip in the newspaper, driving & giving rides in his Mule ATV, and feeding birds, turkeys and hogs around his property, visiting with his

friends and family.

Preceding him in death were his father, Carl Sr., mother, Margaret, and his wife, Laura McGhee.

Those left to cherish his memory are his son, Bobby McGhee (Kim), his daughter, Kimberley McGhee Miller (John), his daughter, Dawn McGhee Villalobos (Gerald), and son, Jay McGhee (Abigail); his grandsons, Wyatt Miller, Hunter McGhee (Shelby), his granddaughter, Braden McGhee; and his great grandson Hudson McGhee, his brother, John McGhee (Elaine), and numerous nephews, nieces, and cousins.

CA loved his family dearly and was adored by all of his children, grandchildren, great grandson, his brother and sister-in-law, and numerous nephews, nieces, cousins, and friends; especially his lifelong friends Walter Bump and Carol Sue Nix who visited and spoke with him often. We will miss him, his laugh, his smile and his wit dearly.

Visitation will be held on Tuesday, September 22, 2020 from 5:30pm-7:30pm at Mission Park Funeral Chapels South. Funeral Service will begin at 11:00am on Wednesday, September 23, 2020 at Mission Park Funeral Chapels South. Interment will follow at Mission Burial Park South.

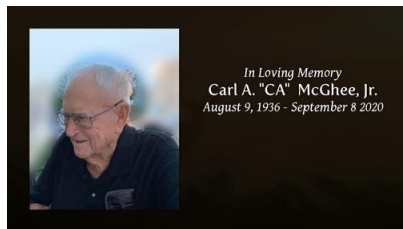
