Carl E. Roberts went to be with the Lord at the age of 87 on November 19, 2018 with his loving family by his side. He was born December 1, 1930 to Merlin and Thelma (Hickman) Roberts in Memphis, Tennessee. In May of 1947, he enlisted in the United States Army where he proudly served as a Shipfitter and Sheet Metal/Welder before shipping off to Korea as Military Police.
