Carlos Madero was born on June 5, 1947 in San Antonio to the late Ernest and Cecilia Madero. He returned to his heavenly home January 20, 2020. He was the husband of Christina. They shared 30 years of marriage.

He attended the public schools of San Antonio and graduated from Jefferson High School in 1967. He attended San Antonio College, taking courses that would help him future his desired career in the San Antonio Police Department. In April 1969, he achieved his dream of joining the San Antonio Police Department. He remained with SAPD until his retirement in April 2004. During his decorated 35 years with the department, he serviced the San Antonio community as patrol officer, was assigned to various special units such as DPU – Direct Patrol Unit, SAFFE – San Antonio Fear Free Environment, he served on the mayor’s security force, and was entrusted to head security for important dignitaries visiting the city.

After retiring, he stayed home. Spending time with his family and tending his gardens for about a year. In April 2005, decided he was not ready to fully retire and Carlos went back to work at San Antonio Airport Police until April 2011 when he decided he wanted to devote more time to his family.

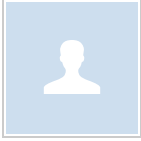
