



Carlos Teniente

November 11, 1940 - May 6, 2020

Carlos Teniente II, 79, died Wednesday, May 6, 2020, at his home after a courageous battle with medial complications.

He was born on November 11, 1940, in San Antonio, Texas. He was the son of Basilio and Mary (Salazar) Teniente. Carlos was the youngest of 12 siblings. He earned his high school diploma from South San Antonio High School in 1956. He immediately joined the Army. Carlos received an Associate in Science from St. Phillips College in 1970. Carlos retired in 1994 after a successful career as a sheet metal/welder for the U.S. Department of Defense. Carlos elected to continue working with Alaska Airlines. His second retirement began in 2004.

Besides spending time with his family, Carlos had a passion for education, the elderly and veterans. He was on the school board in Adak, Alaska for over 10 years. He wanted to ensure that children had the foundation to succeed in their chosen career path. Carlos served as an ombudsman for the elderly while he resided in Fresno, California. He wanted the elderly to be treated with respect and kindness. Carlos also served as a docent for the Legion of Valor Museum. It was his way of honoring his two brothers and other service members that died in America's wars.

Carlos is survived by his wife of 58 years, Gloria (Lazalde) Teniente; his daughter, Cynthia Teniente Matson and her husband, Michael Matson and their two sons, Phillip and Wyatt Matson; his daughter, Rebecca Teniente; and many nieces and nephews.
