Although we didn't call each other everyday, it's as if did, our calls would last 30 minutes to an hour talking about anything and everything. You always lifted my spirits and made me laugh. You taught me to be strong! You were my inspiration when I went through breast cancer 10 years ago. I remember how positive and strong you were when you went through your own cancer about 15 years ago. I was with you the day your doctor gave you the news and I instantly began crying while you stayed calm and strong telling me not to cry because you'd be fine. You told the doctor "okay, let's do whatever needs to be done". You beat that cancer and rarely complained about the pain but instead joked with the oncology staff and always left their office making them laugh with your silliness and constantly saying something intentionally inappropriate that made them laugh even harder. No doubt you were their favorite patient.

My life has forever been changed without you in it. I feel the emptiness and a flood of emotions knowing I can't see or hear your voice, with the exception of several voicemails I kept from the missed calls. You weren't just my mother but a best friend too. There wasn't anything we couldn't discuss. You lived life to the fullest and on your own terms. You were always such a giving and lovely person with a heart of gold, willing to help anyone who needed it, giving food or anything you could offer, even when you yourself needed it and didn't have it to give. You never asked for help but instead gave it.

I loved the way you would just join in singing with any Mariachi's performing at any event. You also loved to dance and definitely had your own style! You were a hoot and didn't let others bring you down, you did you! You were always the life of any party and many young people gravitated to you instantly.

You will be missed not just by us (your children) but by many whose life you touched in one way or another. When you left you took a piece of my heart with you and my life will never be the same without you. I will eternally carry you in my heart. I do find some solace knowing you are now in Heaven with grandma and grandpa and your partner in crime (lol) my aunt Marylou and all your other sisters and brothers who passed before you.
