April 4, 1941 - April 25, 2009

Carol JoAn Pantoja, 68, former Project Manager of Casa Helotes Senior Citizen Center died after an extended battle with COPD on Saturday, April 25, 2009. Carol was born in Okabena, Minnesota on April 4, 1941, where her father, Maynard Bloom was a Depot Agent for the railroad and her mother Catherine Kay Plut Bloom was the Postmistress for the US Postal Service. She graduated from Okabena High School in 1959 as Salutatorian of her class. After high school, Carol received a certificate in accounting and followed in her mother into the postal service. She became Postmaster in Okabena in 1974. After moving to San Antonio, Texas in 1979, she continued her service in the USPS as a letter carrier. In 1982, she became postmaster in Helotes, Texas. She also was an active member of Delta Sigma Epsilon for many years serving the Helotes community. In 2005, she was named Outstanding Civic Leader of the Year by the Helotes Masonic Lodge #1429. She is survived by her husband of 27 years, Severiano Pantoja, Jr. Survivors also include three children Teresa, John, and Christine; 4 stepchildren Cynthia, Stephanie, Sam and Cathy; a brother Ron Bloom of Minnesota; 7 grandchildren; one great grandchild, several beloved cousins and many cherished lifetime friends. A 7:00 p.m. Memorial Service will be celebrated on Thursday, April 30, 2009 at Mission Park Funeral Chapels North. A 10:00 a.m. Mass will be celebrated on Friday, May 1, 2009 at Our Lady of Guadalupe Catholic Church in Helotes, TX followed by a brief Inurnment Service in Mission Burial Park North. Carol was
