Carolina A. Ochoa was called home to the Lord on July 1, 2020. Carrie, as she was known to her friends, or Grandma, to her 5 grandchildren and 6 great grandchildren was born in Rotan, TX on 23 July 1928. She is survived by her husband Henry, her daughters Ruby O. Anderson of San Antonio, and Debra Ochoa Galvan of Houston, in addition to her sister's Regina Torres and Ofelia Urias. Her brothers and sister; Freddy, Jesse, Max, Paul, Pete and Irene preceded her in death.

Carolina was married to the love of her life, Enrique "Henry" Ochoa for 67 years. Carrie did spend 4 years as a proud military spouse with her husband in service to the U.S. Air Force at Keesler AFB, MS. She moved back to her native south Texas in 1955 and remained in San Antonio until her passing. Carolina enjoyed taking her 2 young daughters on camping trips in south Texas, but also on bigger adventures like driving thru the Grand Canyon and on to the west coast. Carrie understood the value of hard work growing up in the 1930's and 1940's. She would often times tell the stories of picking cotton in the fields of Boerne

TX and talk about the blisters and bleeding hands it took to help support her family. For the past 30 years she has spent time watching the grandkids as her daughters careers demanded more "Grandma time" with babysitting and just helping out. Carolina treasured that time spend in the development of each of her 5 grand-children; Caroline, Jaclyn, Veronica, Debra Jean, and Ashley. She talked fondly of that time together with each of them.
