



## Carroll Dean Hendrix

February 5, 1933 - January 7, 2022

Carroll Dean Hendrix passed away on Friday, January 7, 2022 in San Antonio, Texas. He was born on February 5, 1933 in Hickory, North Carolina to the late Lemuel and Tina (Sheehan) Hendrix. He was united in marriage to Alicia De La Fuente on June 13, 1954, in the historic San Fernando Cathedral. Carroll honorably served 23 years with the U.S. Air Force as MSGT.
