Born in 1940, to parents Clifton Walker and Minerva Dorsey, Catherine Amnion Walker grew up in Mount Clemens, Michigan surrounded by her loving family, including her three sisters, Cynthia, Sharon and Trushania.

In 1957, she married a young airman, L.D. Linson, with whom she had four children: Desiree, Anthony, Lorenzo and Kendall. As a military wife and working mother she spent the next 26 years raising her children, traveling the world, including Japan, Michigan, Okinawa and Texas, and working a number of jobs that included Texas Instrument and as a Civilian Administrative Assistant for the US Air Force.

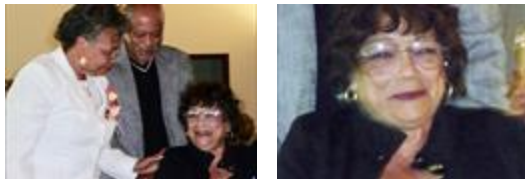
