



## Cecil Eugene Smith

March 22, 1932 - November 20, 2008

Cecil Eugene Smith, devoted husband, father, grandfather, brother and friend, passed away on November 20, 2008. Cecil, known as Smitty to his many friends, was born in Caledonia, MS on March 22, 1932 and lived much of his young life in Spanish Fort, Alabama. He served in the Army, then returned to Alabama and married the love of his life, Marie on December 11, 1953. With the pending closure of Brookley Field, Smitty and Marie moved the family to San Antonio and he continued his career as a civil servant at Kelly AFB. His career allowed opportunities to travel the world and he and his family lived in Germany and Taiwan before returning to San Antonio where he retired from civil service in 1981.

As all who knew him will attest, Smitty never met a stranger. His passions included his family, friends, golf, fishing and hunting. He is survived by his loving wife of 55 years, Marie Sheffield Smith, daughter Carla Smith and her family Judy and Cody, his son Terry Smith, his wife Mary Anne, sons Joshua and Matthew, sisters Grace Nelson, Gloria Hodges and many nieces and nephews.

His life will be celebrated on Wednesday November 26, 2008 at Mission Park North. The viewing will begin at 11:00am, the service at noon with the internment to follow at Ft. Sam Houston at 1:30pm.
