Cecil Willis, 93, passed away Sunday morning February 27th. Born 01-12-1918 in Austin TX, 3 blocks from Longhorn Stadium. He attended his first UT football game at the age of 6 and his last at the age of 91. Cecil is best known for his love of football, the nursery, landscaping business, and his passion in both the State and Federal Education System. Cecil spent his entire life devoted to his family, teaching, coaching and advocating for public, vocational, and athletic educational curriculums throughout the State of Texas. In 1965 he was assigned at the request of President Lyndon B. Johnson to the Executive Office of the White House to develop the National Job Corps Program which still exists today.

He is predeceased by his wife, Gladys Marie Willis.

Survived by his daughter Kathy Willis, Two Grandsons; Kevin and Jennifer Ficke and James Reeves and Jenn Mossburg. Two Great Grandsons Jaxson and Jace Ficke, a special nephew John Willis and family and his favorite dog Kayden. Surrounded and given strength for 70 years by the boys, now men, who call him "coach."
