Cecilia Hermes Tuley age 93 of San Antonio passed away Sunday, April 14, 2013.

She was born July 17, 1919 in Hallettsville, TX to Theodore and Mary Hermes, who were German immigrants.

Cecilia was a pioneering woman who left the family farm and moved to the big city of San Antonio during a time when it was uncommon to do so. While working for the telephone company she met Everett John Tuley at the Catholic Women's Home where she resided. They married in 1951.

Being a loving wife and mother she provided a nurturing home for her five children and husband during Everett's 28 years of service in the Air Force.

Along with Everett, Cecilia was one of the founding parishioners of St. Lawrence Catholic Church. She was an active member of St. Lawrence for over 60 years. Cecilia served as a Eucharist Minister; CCD teacher; festival donation coordinator; and a member of the Altar Society, SCJ associates, and the Sunshine Senior Club.
