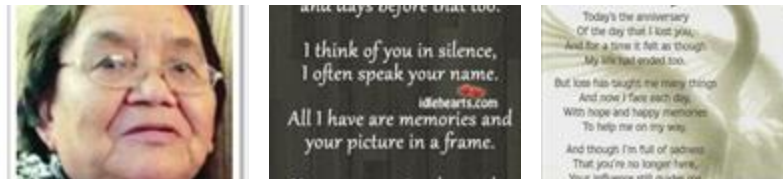
“ Mami,
