July 21, 1939 - November 27, 2009

Charles "Chuck" Angelini, Jr. left our world to be with the Heavenly Father on November 27, 2009. Chuck was born July 21, 1939 and was raised in San Antonio, TX. He attended Brackenridge High School and worked at the family's restaurant: Charlie's Café. In 1956 he joined the US Navy and was stationed at Treasure Island in San Francisco, CA. He was attached to the USS Wilkinson Destroyer Leader in Long Beach, CA. He returned to San Antonio and married Pat Angelini on October 24, 1969. He ventured into the nightclub business and became the prominent owner of The Loser's Club and The Playpen. After several years in the club business he focused his efforts on a more family orientated business and started working for his brother-in-law Butch Mayhew and sister Hilda at Modern Pest Control. He then opened his own company, Century Pest Control, Inc. in 1975 that continues to operate under his son Chas Angelini. Chuck was a devoted husband, father, and grandfather Poppy and his memories will remain forever in the hearts of all who loved him. He was preceded in death by his parents Charlie and Aurora Angelini. Chuck is survived by his loving wife, Pat Angelini, sons Chas Angelini and his wife Nilda, Tom Fitzhugh, and grandson Charlie Angelini, of San Antonio, TX.
