Charles Leon Barnett passed away 7-2-09, at the age of 76. Leon was born 9-22-32 in Sherman TX. He attended Navarro Jr. College, was a walk on Basketball player, after scoring 36 points against SMU he received a full scholarship, he went on to be the teams MVP and an All American. He attended Austin College and earned a BA. On 5-28-56 Leon graduated from Austin college and married his high school sweetheart Mary Fernandez, the same day. He served in the Army for two years. Leon retired from Chase Bank in 1994 after 20 years. Leon continued to play basketball until his later years, in 1999 the Senior Olympic team he played for, the Untied Eagles won the State of Texas Senior Olympic Basketball tournament. He is survived by wife Mary Barnett, son Charles Barnett, daughter Melissa Barnett, mother Velma Burch and brother James Barnett.
