Charles W. Caldwell, Jr. went to be with our Lord October 12, 2010 at the age of 83. He was a loving husband, father, grandfather and friend. Charles will be missed by all who knew and loved him. Upon graduation from Chaminade HS in 1945, Charles, a native New Yorker, joined the US Navy and served during WWII. He married his wife of 60 years, Dolores Costello on October 12, 1950, in Queens, NY. He received his Electrical Engineering Degree from Polytechnic Institute of Brooklyn in 1956. He subsequently received his Professional Engineering licenses in New York, Michigan, and New Jersey. During his 30 years as a partner with Edward Sears and Associates, he headed major construction projects for the Archdiocese of New York. His expertise was in the construction of medical facilities and educational institutions. During the last 10 years of his professional life he worked as the Northeast Area Chief Electrical Engineer for the IRS. Upon his retirement, Charles and Dolores moved to Ephrata, PA and spent many wonderful years traveling the world and spending time with family. In 2007 they moved to San Antonio to be closer to family. Charles was preceded in death by his son Tommy and is survived by his wife, Dolores, sons Charles W. Caldwell, III and Jim Caldwell Linda; daughters Jane Herrel Kraig and Ann Greene Danny;

daughter-in-law Suzanna; 15 grandchildren and one great-grandchild.
