Charles Edwin Dyer was born May 26, 1926 and went to be with the Lord on February 25, 2024 at the age of 97 years. He graduated from Hot Wells High School. He joined the army in August, 1944 and completed his tour of duty in October, 1946. Edwin was the last World War II member of the 108th Infantry Regiment. He enjoyed a successful career for many years with Clark Printing. He was a long time member of The Baptist Temple Church in San Antonio. Edwin was a proud member of the Harlandale Masonic Lodge #1213. He also enjoyed over 30 years of membership in the Mopar Muscle Club of San Antonio showing his 3 favorite Mopar vehicles.

Edwin married the love of his life, Jorene Ham Dyer, on May 3, 1958. They celebrated their Golden Anniversary in 2008.

Edwin was preceded in death by his parents, Orville and Ruth Dyer, his loving wife, Allie Jorene Dyer and his sister, Dolores Dyer.
