Charles R. Hood, age 92, a longtime resident of San Antonio, passed from this life in Kerrville on Thursday, Sept. 3, 2015. He was born Dec. 18, 1922, the second of five children born to Homer Isaac and Annie Letitia Hood. He was a graduate of Georgetown High School and attended Abilene Christian College before enlisting in the Marine Corps where he served in WWII.
