Charles Stanley Roberts, 83, passed away on May 12, 2014 surrounded by his loving family. He was born June 22, 1930 in Ebony, Texas to Loyt and Mildred Reeves Roberts. He graduated from Thomas Jefferson High School in 1948, received a B.A. from Trinity University, and his M.Ed. from Southwest Texas State University, San Marcos.
