



## Charles A. Tingle

August 31, 1941 - June 12, 2008

Charles A. "Chuck" Tingle, 66, beloved husband, father and grandfather, passed away on Thursday, June 12, 2008, after an extended illness. Tingle was born Aug. 31, 1941, to Leslie E. and Mary Tingle in San Antonio, Texas. He was a graduate of Northside High School in 1959 and Texas A&M University in 1963. At A&M, he was a proud member of "Easy Come, Easy Go" Squadron 2 in the Air Force wing of the Corps of Cadets. After graduating from A&M with a business degree, Tingle worked in retail sales positions with Sears Roebuck Co., Montgomery Ward, O.R. Mitchell Dodge, Gunn-Betts Oldsmobile and Tom Benson Chevrolet. Later, Tingle switched career gears and earned a state teaching certificate at Angelo State University. He served as a substitute teacher at Edgewood and Roosevelt high schools before gaining a full-time position as a vocational teacher at Burbank and South San high schools for over 25 years until retiring in 2004. Through it all, Tingle was an avid sports fan, especially when it came to his beloved Texas Aggies. Trips with his family to Kyle Field for football games were among his most cherished memories. Chuck Tingle is survived by his wife of 46 years, Diane; one son, Travis Tingle and his wife, Lisa; and two daughters, Tracy Inscore and her husband, Lane; Jill Potter and her husband Jeff, all of San Antonio; and four grandchildren, Jacob and Zachry Tingle; Kendall and Kylee Inscore.
