Chester Bell Thomas Hovermale, age 85, passed away at BAMC Hospital in San Antonio, Texas on August 23, 2007. Chester was born on May 26, 1922 in Berkeley Springs, West Virginia to Harry Webster Hovermale and Agnes Naomi Dawson Hovermale. He was preceded in death by his brothers, Harry V. Diz Hovermale, Donald Lee Hovermale; sisters, Helen Ray Burkhart, Earle Marie Crow, Edith Cordelia Householder. He is survived by his beloved wife, Rebecca Jenkins Hovermale; children, Cheslee Inselmann & husband Don, Jerry Dennis Hovermale, Stephen Slocombe, Kimberly Slocombe; grandchildren, Andrew Inselmann, Kaleigh Moreland, Zachary Reisz, Hope Elizabeth Hovermale; 2 great-grandchildren; brother, Herbert Leroy Hovermale and numerous nieces, nephews and cousins.
