Christina Katherine Lindsay Kathy, age 62, born October 20, 1945 at Letterman General Hospital in San Francisco to Henry C. Neal, Jr. Jack and Elizabeth Anne Krueger Neal Betty and passed away on April 27, 2008. Graduated from Capuchino High School in Millbrae, California and attended College of San Mateo. After moving to San Antonio worked for two food brokerage firms – first, Rossett Brokerage and then Luke Soules now Acosta. Loved her job and her co-workers, many of whom became her best friends. She felt at home in Texas and considered herself more a Texan than a Californian. She is survived by her mother, Betty Neal, her daughter Sarah Ness and her grandson Jacob Sanders, age 6, who called her Mamah and thought she was the greatest. She passed away from gastric cancer which was diagnosed 9 months ago. Kathy survived surgery, chemotherapy and a second surgery and fought courageously until the end. Continued to go to the office throughout the entire period of her illness. She had unusually beautiful hands worthy of a commercial hand model and also had a green thumb. She created beautiful gardens wherever she lived and enjoyed gardening, usually without gloves.
