CJ was a natural born protector of those he loved, and his love was so full and unselfish. He never cared who was around when he showed his affection and once he wrapped his arms around you, you could feel the love and the need not to let go. CJ's presence was always known, since his huge personality lit up any room, especially during family gatherings. He loved adventure, and was never scared to try new things, and his dancing, oh, his dancing, made everyone celebrate, and cheer and smile. For being such a tall, strong young man, his nature was so loving and so gentle. He kept true to himself and was not a boastful or prideful young man. He took things with grace, and always tried to look forward to his future and the change he wanted for himself and to make those he loved proud. CJ is survived by his mother, Veronica Farias (Barbosa), his father, Christopher Farias, his sisters, Katherine Farias and Victoria Farias; his maternal grandmother (Grandma), Luzelba Ramirez, his paternal
