Cipriano Ordones, 87, passed into our Lord's hands on November 20, 2024. He was born on September 9, 1937, to Jose and Maria Ordones in San Antonio, Texas.

Cipriano began his military service with the U.S. Army National Guard at an early age, serving for four years before joining the U.S. Air Force, where he dedicated 26 years of service to his country.

He was predeceased by his beloved wife of 43 years, Hermelinda T. Ordones, and his parents, Jose and Maria Ordones. Cipriano is survived by his son, Bobby Ordones; daughter, Linda O.
