



## Ciriaco Castro

August 8, 1922 - June 9, 2018

Ciriaco Castro went to be with the Lord on June 9th, 2018 in San Antonio, Texas at the age of 95. He was born to Cleofas and Margarita Castro on August 8th, 1922 in Weslaco, Texas. He is preceded in death by his wife, Sixta, sons, Daniel (Frances) and Cirio, grandson Cirio Jr. and great-granddaughter Amber. He is survived by daughters Maria de Jesus Gover (Howard), Genoveva Patlan (Ruben) and Adela Bratton (Jesse), fifteen grandchildren, forty-three great-grandchildren and thirty-four great-great grandchildren.

Grandpa survived the beaches of Normandy and the Battle of the Bulge during WWII, for which he received a Purple Heart and many other awards. But his greatest battle was his decision to finally leave us and join his wife and sons in heaven.

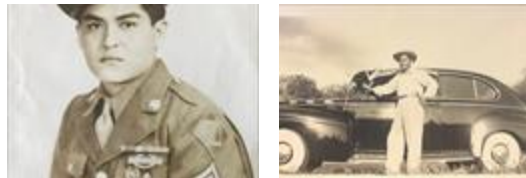
