Our beloved mother, Clara Gonzalez Cuellar joined her beloved husband of 66 years, Joe L. Cuellar, in heaven on October 11, 2023 at the age of 87.

There was nothing more precious to our mother than her children and grandchildren. Her love language was food and she loved nothing more than keeping us all fed. If we didn't eat we were probably sick so she would make something that would cure whatever might be ailing. Her love came from the kitchen and no one who ate at her table ever left hungry.
