The family moved to New Orleans, Louisiana, where he attended Saint Aloysius High School. Cj served in the U.S. Navy. As a young man, he returned to his birth place: San Antonio, Texas. He worked for more than 30 years at Southwestern Bell, now AT&T, in various roles including as a journeyman and a FACS Operations manager. It was during his career at Southwestern Bell that he met his devoted wife, Donna.

He will be missed by everyone who knew and loved him.
