



## Claudette Dykstra Lamphier

July 27, 1951 - March 10, 2020

Claudette Dykstra Lamphier, 68, passed away suddenly Tuesday, March 10, 2020. She is survived by her husband of 48 and a half years, Victor (Veteran USAF with service in Vietnam, Central America, and Desert Shield/Desert Storm), and daughter, Autumn Lamphier and wife Miranda Rodriguez of DeSoto TX; nieces Terri Calbert and husband Richard, and Carol Perkins, all of Houston TX, and many friends, aunts, uncles, cousins, and cats. 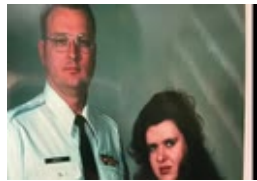
