



## Clayton "Scott" Ohrwall

October 29, 1956 - June 21, 2015

Clayton "Scott" Ohrwall, 58, of San Antonio, TX passed away in his sleep on June 21, 2015. Scott was born on October 29, 1956 in Kenosha, WI to Audrey Mack and Clayton Ohrwall. He grew up in the Twin Lakes, WI area, attended Randall Elementary, and was a 1975 graduate of Wilmot Union High School. After graduating from the University of Wisconsin – Stout with a Bachelor's Degree in Hotel and Restaurant Management, Scott went on to manage various restaurants in Wisconsin and Texas. He was a resident of San Antonio for most of the last 23 years, where he established the non-profit corporation International Angel Ministries, and worked very devotedly as a Reverend, spiritual counselor and spiritual teacher.

He was a shining light, a very positive individual, and his love of life was truly amazing and contagious.
