



Cleo Chubby Knudson

October 22, 1920 - November 4, 2005

Cleo Chubby Gordon Knudson, of San Antonio, TX, died on November 4, 2005. He was born October 22, 1920, in the Mustang Community near Meridian in Bosque County, TX, to Molden and Mathea Carlson Knudson. He attended the Mustang School, graduated from Cranfills Gap High School as well as Clifton College after which he successfully completed the Civil Service Examination and was sent to Duncan Field in San Antonio. During World War II, he served with a civilian detachment assigned to Station X in England to repair B-17 aircraft, returning in 1944. He subsequently enlisted in the Navy and obtained the rank of Aviation Machinist Mate Second Class. After the war, he resumed his Civil Service career at Kelly AFB, proudly serving for over 41 years. He was a member of the Masonic Order and an active member of Hope Lutheran Church.

This loving husband and father is survived by his wife of 52 years, the former Juanita Nita Moise Bölzle; a son, Kent; a daughter, Karen and her husband Kirk Smith; and two sisters, Mrs. Ozelle Samples of Dallas and Mrs. Muriel Johnson of Sherman, brother-in-law, Glenn Bölzle.
