



Clester Wade Hornsby Jr.

Clester Wade Hornsby Jr was born in Taylor, Texas on April 16, 1923. He passed away in his home of 39 years on December 9, 2016. He graduated from Edison High School in 1941 and began his college education in engineering at Texas A&M. This was interrupted by World War II, in which he served in the army as an infantryman. Before being shipped overseas he married his high school sweetheart, Peggy Ruth Fisher, on March 4, 1944. They enjoyed a loving marriage of 65 years before her passing.

After the war he attended Pharmacy School at the University of Texas. He was a pharmacist for over 50 years. Highlights of his career included owning Wade's Pharmacy and retiring from HEB. Wade was preceded in death by his wife Peggy, daughter Janice, son Grady and grandson Judson. He is survived by sons Chuck and John, and daughter Paula, 12 grandchildren, 25 great grandchildren, and 4 great great grandchildren. Wade was a loving husband and father, loyal friend, avid square dancer, and committed church member of Zion Lutheran Church. Wade touched many lives and will be sorely missed.

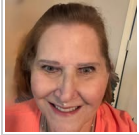
