



Colonel Clinton Morgan Glenny, USAF Ret.

July 11, 1934 - December 9, 2016

Colonel Clinton Morgan Glenny, USAF Ret, took his Final Flight West on Friday, December 9, 2016. Clint was born July 11, 1934 in Bronxville, New York, to the late Clinton H. Glenny and Lillian B. Morgenweck. He was 82 years old. He graduated from Mount Carmel High School in Los Angeles, California and attended Loyola Marymount University in Los Angeles, California, where he played four years on the baseball team, was a member of the Phi Sigma Kappa fraternity, he also joined the United States Air Force ROTC program. After graduating LMU with a Bachelors of Business Administration, he completed the Squadron Officer School and the Industrial College of the Armed Forces, embarking on a military career. In 1956, Colonel Glenny completed pilot training at Goodfellow Air Force Base, earning his wings. He served with Strategic Air Command's 320th Bombardment Wing as a B-47 pilot. Later at Grissom Air Force Base, Indiana, he piloted the B-58 "Hustler", the world's first supersonic bomber, his favorite airplane.

Colonel Glenny devoted 30 years of commissioned service to active duty and Air Force assignments, retiring as a command pilot with the rank of Colonel. His combat roles included well over three hundred missions and 6,000 flying hours including the Cuban Missile Crisis. He flew over the former Republic of Vietnam and the Kingdom of Laos. His awards and decorations include the Distinguished Flying Cross, four Meritorious Service Medals, 11 Air Medals, Legion of Merit Medal and the Air Force Commendation Medal. The discipline

and patriotism he learned in the Air Force never left him as friends and family will attest.

Colonel Glenny married the love of his life Anna Belle “Ann” Simonton on August 20, 1960, in Phoenix, Arizona. Together they spent the next 56 years traveling the world as a military couple, raising a family and socializing with countless friends. He was a member of the Cibolo Creek Community Church, B-58 Hustler Association and Fair Oaks Ranch Country Club, where they built a home and many happy memories.

Colonel Glenny is survived by his wife Ann, daughter Diana Rosas and husband Bobby, son Clint Glenny and wife Susan. Grandchildren Laura Stankich and husband Jacob, Tyler Rosas and wife Abigail, Morgan Glenny and Holt Glenny.

He is preceded in death by his beloved son Clifford Carl Glenny and two sisters, Karen Glenny and Carolee Lynn.
