Clyde Manon Lanford, known as Manon to friends and family was born in San Antonio, Texas, on September 14, 1930, and went to be with his Lord and Savior on August 9th, 2018 in San Antonio, at the age of 87. Manon was preceded in death by his parents, Clyde B and Edith Lanford and his first wife, Melba Jean Lanford. He was passionate about his wife (both he and Linda were convinced that God had used unknowing friends to introduce them at a church), a concerned and loving “Dad” and a doting, fun “Grandpa.” Lanford worked for over 30 years for Burroughs Corporation and exercised his entrepreneurial spirit even as a child by delivering prescriptions and papers on his bicycle, and later an Indian motorcycle, washing cars, raising rabbits, and owning a restaurant and a business in Washington state. In later years, he dabbled in the stock market. Manon was an avid reader and he loved to travel. Sometimes a dinner out would consist of a road trip to Sea Island in Corpus or some other unexpected adventure.
