Clyde C. Pagel, 99, was called home by his Lord and Savior on May 17, 2015. A true gentleman, he will be deeply missed by all whose lives he touched. Clyde was born on July 7, 1915 to the late Henry and Matilda Pagel in Jackson County Texas. He grew up in and around the San Antonio area and attended Kerrville Tivy High School. From 1942 to 1945 he served in the U.S. Army as part of the 152nd Combat Engineers. During his service he participated in the battles of Makin Island, Saipan, and Okinawa. After the war he returned to San Antonio.

In 1954 he married Margaret Francis Stephens, a nurse at Scott & White Memorial Hospital in Temple, Texas. They made their home in San Antonio and Clyde began a 27 year career with Southwest Research Institute, retiring in 1982. He spent many years serving as a deacon at Baptist Temple Church. Clyde is survived by his wife of 61 years, Margaret; son Tom Suzi Pagel of Waco, TX; daughter Edith Pagel of Austin, TX; grandson Andy D'Leesa Pagel of Plainview, TX; grandson Collin Pagel of New Braunfels, TX; and many loving family members.
