



CMSGT Serge J. Belanger, USAF Ret.

Serge Joseph Belanger passed to his Eternal Rest on Monday, May 30, 2016.

CMSgt. Belanger was born September 30, 1943 in Lac Megantic, Quebec, Canada. He attended Our Lady of Grace Academy grades 1-11 and graduated from Colebrook Academy in Colebrook, New Hampshire.

Prior to enlisting in the USAF in 1961 he worked with his father in Belanger's Garage. His Air Force career included assignments to Gila Bend, AZ, Myrtle Beach, SC, Clearwater, FL, Taipei, Taiwan, Hahn AFB, Germany, Belton, MO, Wiesbaden, Germany, Coco Beach, FL, Portsmouth, NH and Las Vegas, NV where he retired as a Chief Master Sergeant and First Sergeant with the Stealth Fighter Unit.
