Colin Matthew Campa, 22, of San Antonio, died December 30, 2016, as a result of injuries sustained in a motorcycle accident. He was born June 27, 1994, in San Antonio, the son of William and Patricia (Krawietz) Campa. He attended Robert E. Lee High School.

Colin is survived by his mother Patricia Krawietz Campa; his brother William Patrick, his nephew William Solomon, his niece Celeste Margo and his godmother Laura Campa. He also leaves his close friends, several aunts, uncles and cousins. Colin is reunited in death with his father William A. Campa, his grandparents Willam and Sylvia Campa, and Fryderyk and Catherine Krawietz.

Colin loved his niece and nephew, doting on them. He also loved working on cars and it wasn't unusual to find him with grease up to his elbows in his free time. He will be remembered for his kind heart and his giant bear hugs, being 6'5" it wasn't hard to be enveloped in one of his hugs.

At the age of 17, Colin decided to become an organ donor when he obtained his first drivers license. Colin, a miracle child himself, made the ultimate gift with his death in the hopes of creating miracles for others.

Funeral arrangements are being handled by the Mission Park North funeral

home in San Antonio. Visitation hours will be Thursday, January 5 from 12 to 8 pm with the rosary at 7 pm. The funeral mass will be held on Friday, January 6 at noon at St. Gregory the Great Catholic Church in San Antonio. It was Colin's desire to be cremated.
