Who would believe riding a motorcycle on a beautiful fall day in the Texas Hill Country with your husband, Barry Trey D. Greer, III that death would be just around the bend; but it was. On Saturday, October 2, 2010, Colleen R. Greer was critically injured attempting to avoid a car in the road. Though she fought valiantly, she died on October 5, 2010. Born on March 4, 1959 to James Smitty and Shirley Smith, she and her "younger" sister Wanda traveled the world as Air Force brats. Moving to San Antonio, she met the love of her life on a country western dance floor. From then on, Barry and Colleen became inseparable; in fact, "Barry & Colleen" are one word: you cannot say one without the other. Whether bowling, Spurs games, lying by a pool or beach, working on their home, or riding motorcycles, they did it together. The San Antonio Spurs, the Oakland Raiders and the Hartford Insurance Company have lost their greatest fan. Survived by her husband, Barry, her sister Wanda Smith Glock and husband, Steve; parents Smitty and Shirley Smith; son Kelly Auston Keith, III and wife Amy; step-children Kevin and Kelli Greer; best friend Jackie Sutton; mother-in-law Mary Lou Bargnesi; and brother and sister in law, Dean and Linda Greer.

A memorial service will be held at Mission Park North 3401 Cherry Ridge on Thursday, October 7, 2010 at 3:00 p.m.
