



## Colon Lott, Jr.

August 18, 1934 - February 20, 2008

Colon Joseph Lott, Jr. Buddy was born in San Antonio, Texas on August 18, 1934 and passed away on February 20, 2008. He graduated from Peacock Academy in 1953 and went on to join the Navy and Army where he served from 1953 thru 1957. During his lifetime he had worked and been a member of several different organizations such as serving on the Olmos Park Police Department from 1960 – 1963, Bexar County Sheriffs Office from 1963 – 2004, Texas Cavaliers and was a master mason. Some of his other achievements where obtaining a private pilots license, being awarded the Pilots Association Achievement Award, lifetime membership for the Mesquite Trail Drivers Association, San Antonio Livestock Exposition "Life Member" School Tours, Provost Marshall 1980 Alzafar Shrine Temple, Paseo Del Rio Holiday River Parade, Builders Exchange and also worked with Channel 4 WOAI. He was preceded in death by his parents, Colon Joseph Lott Sr. and Emma Qualls Lot and sister, Joyce Damiani. Buddy is survived by his wife, Marshalyn Lott; sons, Colon J. Lott III, Darin Lott and wife Diane, Troy Lott and wife Jami; daughter, Colene Loza-Lott and husband Levy; stepdaughters, Shannon and Shelly Skifter; 13 grandchildren, 1 great granddaughter, numerous aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, many friends and favorite aunt, Rhiller Willoughby.
