Concepcion Chavez went to be with the Lord on Monday, May 22, 2023, at the age of 74. He was born on December 8, 1948, in San Antonio, Texas to Camilo Chavez and Petra Hernandez Chavez.

Concepcion "Chon" was the youngest of five children. He had one sister, Mary Cruz and three brothers, Camilo, Pedro and Armando. Chon graduated from John F Kennedy high school in 1967. He attended Southwest Texas College (now Texas State), where he studied music. He married his high school sweetheart, Sylvia O. Lopez on January 18, 1969, and they had two children together, Concepcion Jr and Rebecca. He then joined the Liberty Band, where he sang backup, played the alto saxophone, and helped write songs. He and Sylvia parted ways in 1977 after 8yrs of marriage. Chon was blessed to later find love again with Norma Campa and they were married on November 20, 1981; and had three children: Theresa, Steven & Andrew. They raised their blended family together until 2002, when they amicably parted ways.

Chon left The Liberty Band in 1981 then began his career as a truck driver while also pursuing his passion of the arts as a photographer. He enjoyed spending his time with his kids and grandkids and watching his beloved Spurs and Dallas Cowboys. Chon was also an avid fisherman and took every opportunity to be at the beach or on a boat fishing.

Hernandez Chavez and his sister Mary Cruz.

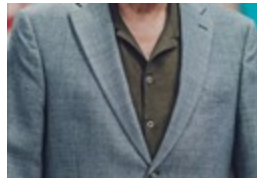
