



## Constance Shaw Kircher

July 29, 1919 - January 12, 2013

Constance Shaw Kircher, born July 29, 1919, went to be with the Lord on Saturday, January 12, 2013 at the age of 93. Mrs. Kircher was born in Ft. Worth, Texas, spent most of her youthful years in Pasadena, Texas and was a San Antonio resident since 1948. After high school, she worked in Civil Service at Ellington Field during World War II.
