Consuelo S. Palomares entered into eternal rest and glory, Friday, May 19, 2006 at the age of 91. She was preceded in death by her parents Miguel and Sabina Palomares and her sister Socorro Rangel. She remained single all her life, but was the “MOTHER” and “GRANDMOTHER” to her sister’s six children. She is survived by her brother Alfredo Palomares, Sr. and sister Mary Palomares. Also surviving her are numerous nieces, nephews, grandnieces and grandnephews. Miss Palomares was an arduous active member in the Catholic Church. Her membership at St. Joseph’s South San and St. Dominic’s in the organizations of Guadalupanas, Legion of Mary, Altar Society, Third Order of St. Francis, Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament Group and a Eucharistic Minister of Communion was her greatest pride. She, along with her long time friend Jean Moore distributed Holy Communion to as many as 25 homebound persons every Wednesday and the first Friday of every month for many years.
