Craig Adams Tips, 95, of Bandera, Texas died peacefully at San Antonio's Methodist Hospital on Wednesday, January 12, 2021. Born October 19, 1925 in San Antonio, Texas, he was the youngest son of Frederick Julius Tips, Sr. and Margaret Chambers Tips. His two brothers, Will Chambers Tips and Fred Julius Tips, Jr. preceded him in death.
