Her passing was due to complications of Friedreichs Axtaxia. A mass of Christian Burial will be held in her honor on Wednesday, January 23, 2019 at 11:30 at St. John Neumann Catholic Church in San Antonio.

Cindy's spirit, strength, courage, and compassion will continue to inspire those who knew her. She showed us all how to live life to the fullest. To know her was to truly love her, and she blessed us all with her love.

She is preceded in death by her father Thomas Summers on October 29, 2012; and her brother David Summers on March 17, 1991.

She is survived by her mother Helen Summers of Schenectady, New York; her sister Karen Summers of Lake Jackson, Texas; her sons and daughters-in-law Ryan and Lara Fondulis of Cibolo, Texas, and Damon and Nicole Fondulis of Red Rock, Texas; her three grandchildren Andy, Lyla, and Indy Fondulis; and many family and friends.
