Deroy Wooster Cain aka DW Cain passed away on Saturday, October 17, 2015 at home in San Antonio, TX. He was born on June 14, 1922 in Waco, TX to Deroy Learned Cain and Leona Bell Cain. He attended Texas A&M University but left for World War II and did his wartime service in the Pacific, later doing service in the Korea theatre, and working as a Flight Engineer on Air Force One with President Kennedy through President Johnson.
