Our mother, Dahlia P. Valdez, was born in Port Arthur, Texas to Marcelino Pelayo and Rebecca del Castillo Pelayo. She later moved with her family to San Antonio, Texas where she attended Ursuline Academy from which she was graduated in May 1946. She married Robert J. Valdez in 1950 and they raised us in the Jefferson High area. Mom was a stay-at-home mother for our early years, sending us to St. Paul's Elementary School and later, the boys to Antonian and Becky to Ursuline. She later became an administrative assistant for the Bexar County Independent School District and the San Antonio Children's Center. She was widowed in 1996 upon the passing of our father. She lived in her home until 2019. Afterwards, she lived with Becky, who cared for her constantly in her home. Above all else, Mom enjoyed being with her family. During her healthy years, she enjoyed all of the holidays and gatherings with family.

Our grandparents, Marcelino and Rebecca Pelayo, predeceased our mother. Mom is survived by her children, Robert E. (Lori) Valdez, Ronald A. (Patricia) Valdez, and Rebecca (Dave) Turner.
