Dale Huntley Robb, 86, passed away Tuesday, April 24, 2007 from complications of a fall. Dale lived a full and rich life, which is celebrated by his wife, children, and granddaughters. Born October 11, 1920 in Flagler, Colorado, Dale attended the University of Colorado before working for the War Department's Emergency Management group. He married Louise Catherine Camp of Platteville, Colorado on April 10, 1942 and entered the Army two months later. After his World War II military service in the, Army Signal Corps, he joined the fledgling Air Force Security Service and moved to San Antonio, Texas, spending almost 30 years working as an electrical engineer on cryptographic equipment at their headquarters in Kelly A.F.B.

Dale loved life: fly fishing, ballroom dancing, dove hunting, travels with his wife, the occasional highball, and constant learning. And he was loved by all that were fortunate enough to know him. He was preceded in death by his parents, Arthur Delmar Robb and Freda Huntley Robb; daughter, Catherine Louise Robb; and brother, Lester Robb.
